THIRD THEFT STING SUSPECT APPREHENDED

On the morning of Friday, June 8, 2012, Det. Jason Grant received a tip that Etienne Saucedo, 19 years of age, of Corsicana, who was wanted for Theft over \$1,500 under \$20,000 in connection with the theft of mattresses from Corsicana Bedding, was at a residence in the 900 block of North 20th Street. Sgt. Todd Morris and Cpl. Trent Parker responded to the address and Saucedo fled into the residence, but was apprehended without incident as he tried to flee out the rear of the residence.

Saucedo was then booked into the Navarro County Jail. Justice of the Peace Vickie Gray arraigned Saucedo and bond was set at \$4,000.

Chief Bratton credited the assistance from the public in locating the suspect and the quick response by Sgt. Morris and Cpl. Parker with the subsequent apprehension of Saucedo.
