At 12:30 p.m. today, March 20, 2017, the Corsicana Police Department was dispatched in reference to an aggravated assault at Walmart, located at 3801 W. Hwy. 31. The complainant stated that an unknown suspect approached a Walmart greeter and began stabbing him with an unknown object. It was determined that the suspect who was wearing a white baseball cap, green shirt and khaki shorts ran eastbound from the scene towards West Park Row.

Multiple Corsicana Police Department units and Navarro County SO units responded to the area in search of the suspect. Area schools & businesses in the immediate area were notified of the threat. Corsicana Police Officers located the suspect approximately a half mile from the location and was placed into custody without incident. The weapon used in the attack has not been determined at this time. The victim was transported to Navarro Regional Hospital. He is in good condition and is expected to be released shortly.
